VISION


In doing so, we hope to encourage and enable women and families to contribute individually and collectively in strengthening our community as a whole.

COVID-19 PRACTICES

Radiant Hands' target client base did not change throughout COVID-19. After assessing our resources, Radiant Hands altered its objectives to better support our families' emotional, physical, and financial wellbeing. Radiant Hands achieved this by translating essential CDC guidelines for families, changing the allocated budget to provide immediate financial assistance due to widespread job loss, and ensuring clients utilized all available government compensation by assisting in filing for unemployment. After assessing clients' new increasing needs due to COVID-19, the Radiant Hands staff developed individual threemonth work plans for families. Radiant Hands implemented all CDC guidelines in our office space, such as requiring masks, social distancing, sanitizing rooms, and scheduling a minimal amount of clients per day in addition to specific time slots for distributions. With CDC restrictions, it was increasingly difficult for families to keep up with the rapid shift of services from in-person to online platforms. Many families lack multiple devices and strong internet connections. They do not possess specific technological skills, so it was difficult to obtain many of the necessary documents before granting assistance while minimizing any communication misunderstandings. However, our case managers never hesitated to stay on the phone to guide them step-by-step through several online applications and taught them how to upload documents. All project planning was implemented over Zoom meetings. Case managers met clients virtually and obtained online the verification documents needed per our policy. PRFs were discussed and approved during financial assistance meetings. All payments were made directly on clients' behalf to vendors. Many clients struggle with leading financially stable lives, especially since several clients lost their jobs or had their hours significantly reduced. Still, with our case managers' support and guidance, individuals filed for external grants or obtained new jobs altogether. Radiant Hands was delighted to help our clients secure jobs to get them one step closer to financial stability.


SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMS

Dental Sponsorship:

Through a generous partnership, several dentists supported clients referred by Radiant Hands who either lost their health insurance or had insurance that did not cover major dental needs. We currently have 100 beneficiaries under this program.

• Family Sponsorship:

With the generous support of our community members, basic monthly expenses were covered for families who cannot survive on their own. We currently have 40 beneficiaries under this program.



COUNSELING

Radiant Hands has been dedicated to providing counseling services for all clients for the community at large. We hired a psychologist who graduated from the University of South Florida and obtained her Bachelor of Arts in Psychology & Criminology, as well as her Master of Arts in Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling, with a concentration in Marriage and Family Therapy. She is a dually licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT) and Mental Health Counselor (LMHC) in the state of Florida, as well as a nationally Certified Rehabilitation Counselor (CRC) and Certified Eating Disorders Specialist (CEDS).

RADIANT KITCHENS



Our Radiant Kitchens ladies catered numerous events this year and finished working with USF students on creating their recipe book which is now being sold at the Radiant Hands office. They also are preparing frozen food that is ready to be cooked. This year they catered for big events such as the Radiant Hands Annual Dinner 2021, where they served over 200 people.

RADIANT TAILORS

Radiant Tailors gained a lot of customers this year alongside a lot of positive feedbacks.

Moving to the new space made it better for the ladies to organize their work and be more efficient.



COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

• Donations:

The generous donations of our community was not only limited to financial support, but also to in-kind donations like furniture, household items, clothes and computers. All of these items were moved to our storage units and are used when a family arrives.

Volunteers:

Our wonderful volunteers never ceased to amaze us this year with their selflessness and dedication. They have been there actively helping Radiant Hands through all times.

We are very thankful to these amazing people.





HOUSING

Our staff and volunteers routinely coordinated together to furnish houses for our refugees using donated items that are still in good condition. They make sure they don't miss out on any small detail that concerns the families starting from large furniture to the smallest decorative item. The result is a nicely furnished and cozy house where the refugees can feel motivated to start working on their dreams and capturing opportunities to eventually become successful, independent individuals.



COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Back to School Supplies Drive

During the last weekend of July, all donated school items are packed into backpacks by Girl Scout troops and distributed to all school-aged children of our needy families.

Eid Bazaar

Ramadan food boxes

Every year, Radiant Hands makes sure the families receive their needs for the month prior to the start of Ramadan. We provide halal meat, dry goods and dates. These boxes are given to the families during the weekend before Ramadan starts.

MEDICAL_W_ASSISTANCE



Our most delightful news of the year was expanding our services and comprising new partners into our journey. Free Refugee Clinic is the name of the project we added to our multipurpose center. This project has brought relief for many refugees as they have their health checkups by professionals such as Dr. Masoud Khan, the head of Pioneer Foundation, and Dr. Aimal Nikamal, who help immensely by coming in monthly and checking on our refugees.

The need for medications is assessed and accordingly provided by Radiant Hands or the pioneer foundation. This service is also helping other clients who have no insurance plans and need health checks.



AFGHAN REFUGEES



With the arrival of many Afghan families into Tampa, we instituted the Afghan Resettlement Program. 130 volunteers were gathered and divided into 8 teams. 2,000 hours were spent on various services. These hours were provided by those volunteers to welcome our beloved families warmly and make them feel at home while everything gets prepared: from a cozy house to food and assistance with all they need. We welcomed 121 families, housed 42 families, furnished 32 houses, provided 1544 individual hot meals and provided 350 food boxes.
